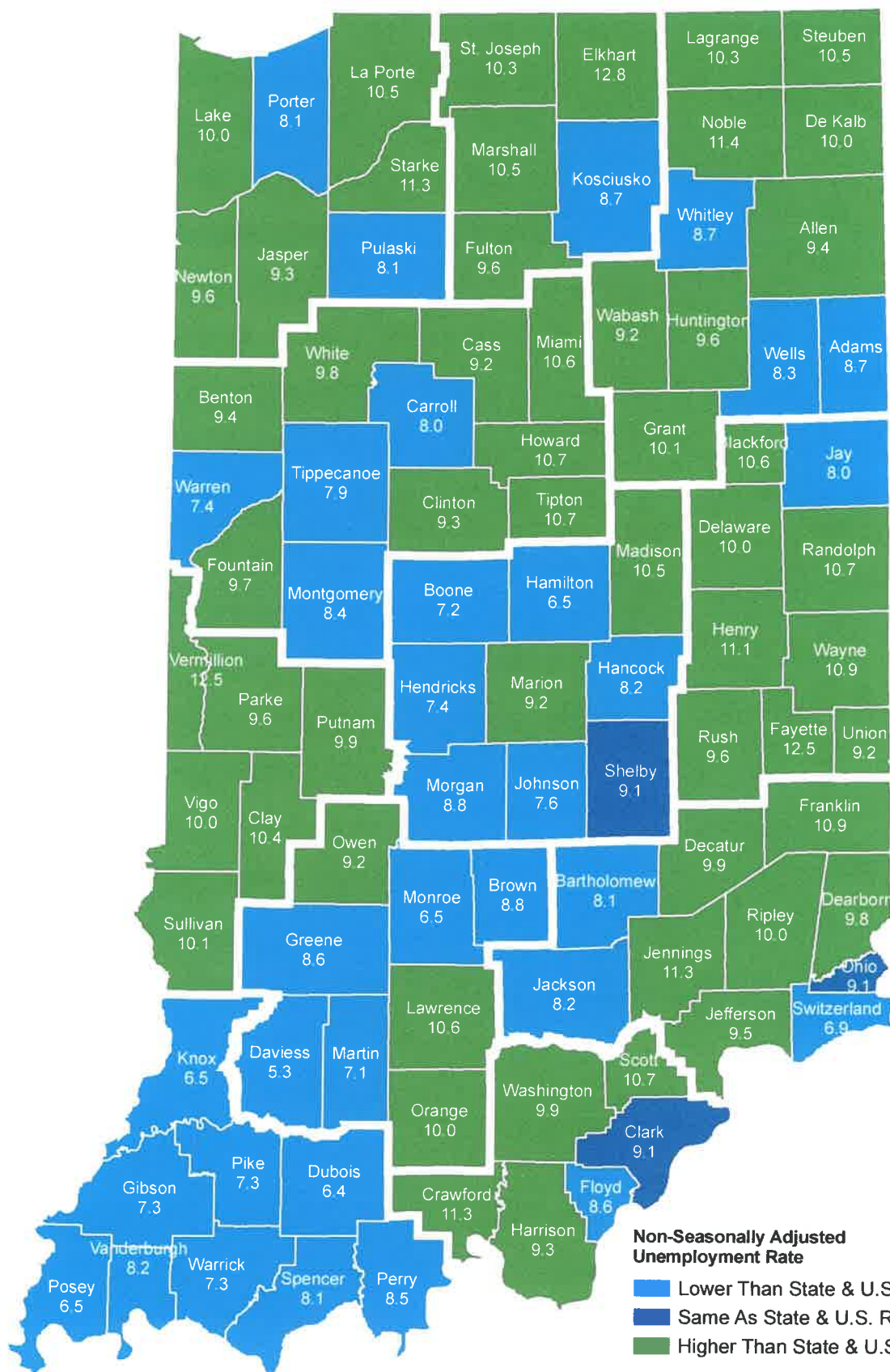


County Unemployment Rates December 2010 - Non Seasonally Adjusted
