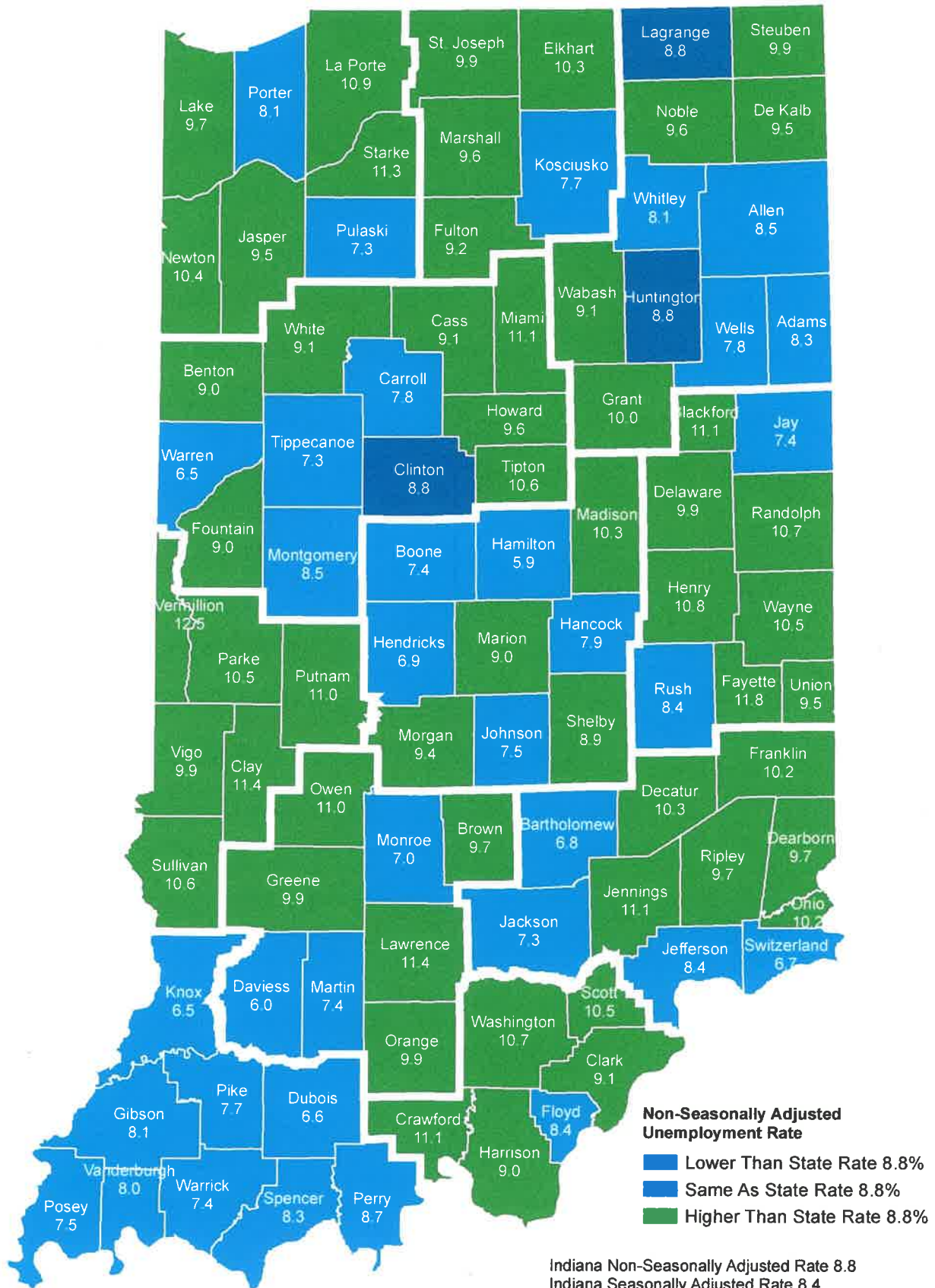


County Unemployment Rates February 2012 - Non Seasonally Adjusted
