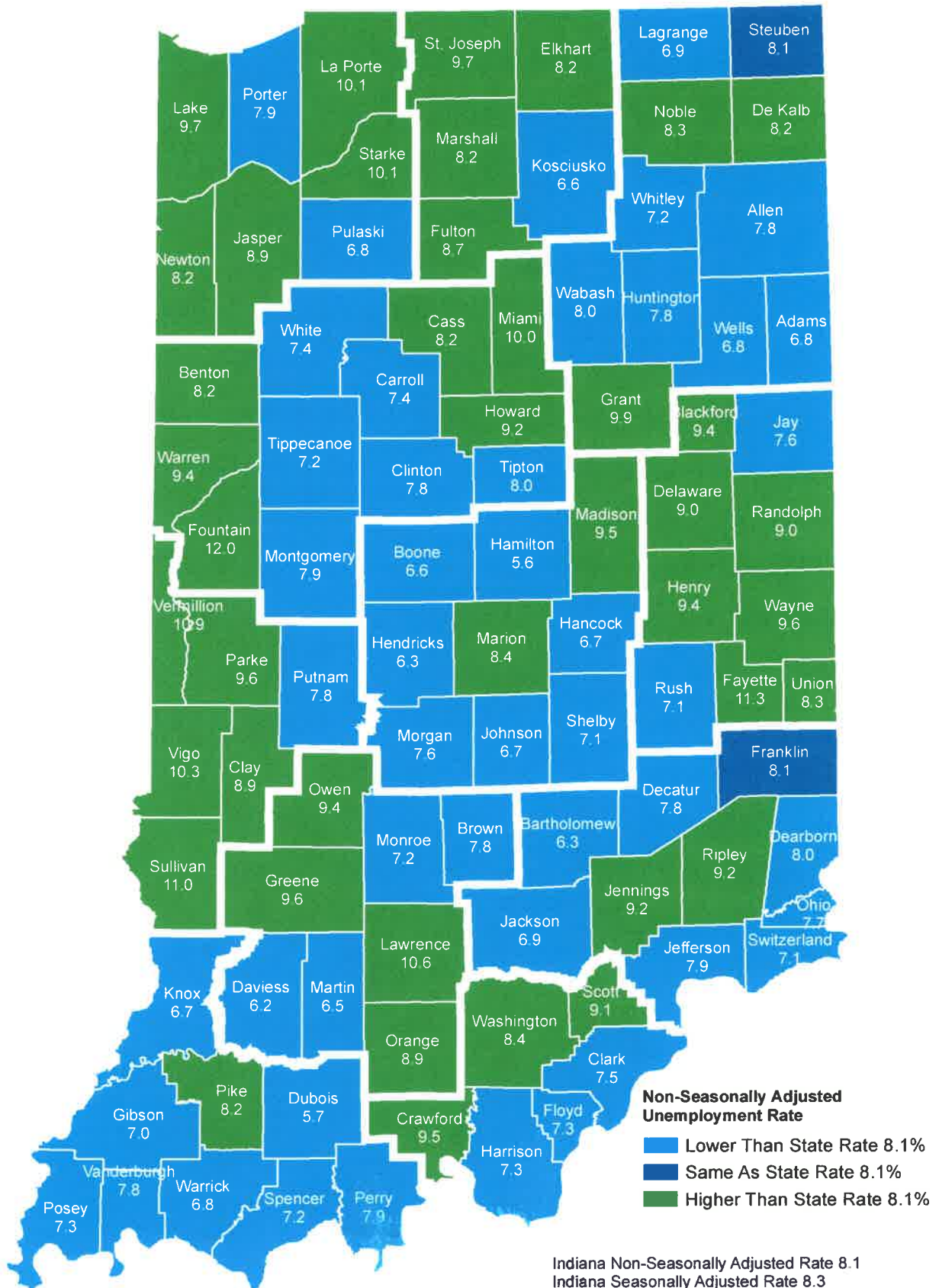


County Unemployment Rates May 2013 - Non Seasonally Adjusted
