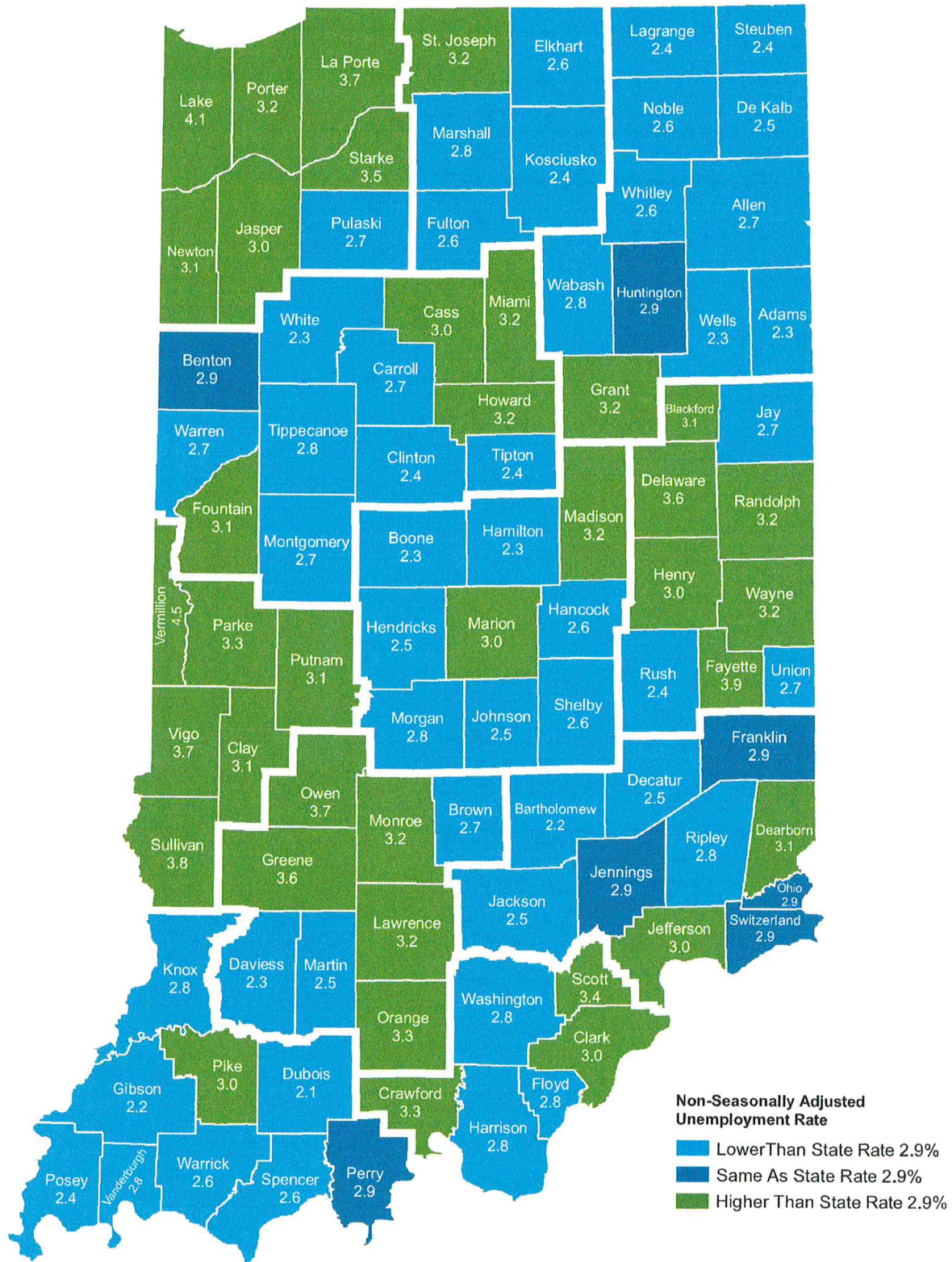


# County Unemployment Rates May 2019 - Non Seasonally Adjusted
