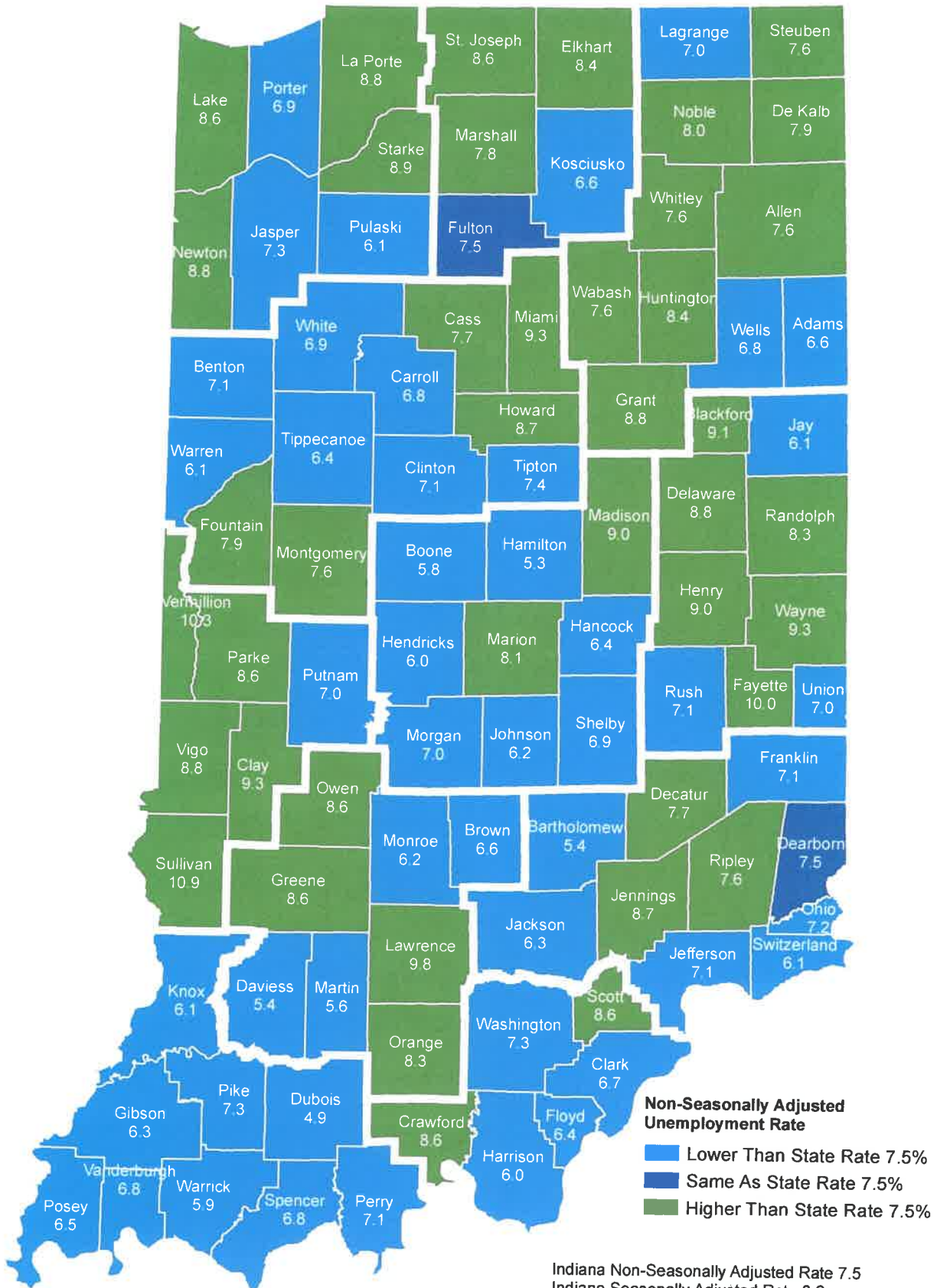


County Unemployment Rates
